For the POLICE call 101 for non emergencies and 999 for emergencies. If you do see anything untoward in the village it is always worth reporting on 101 and advising Neighbourhood Watch.

Most of the village is a “No cold calling zone” so we *should not* have cold callers.

It was good to have a Police Surgery in the village in July – PCSOs Michelle Wilkinson and Kerry Croutear will be hosting another one in the winter.

Our local Police do patrol the village daily – for which we are very grateful.
