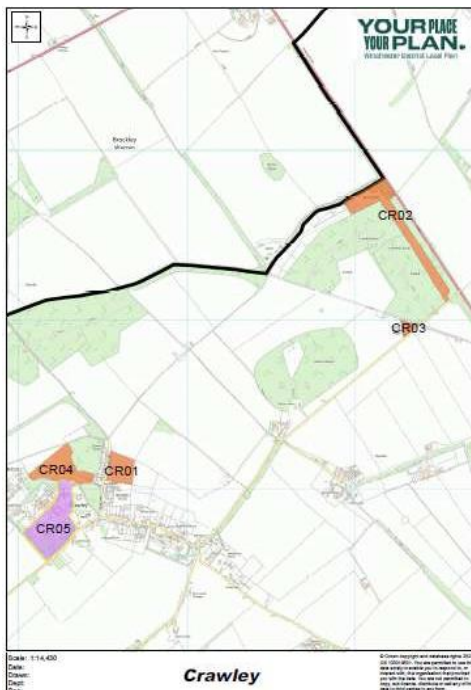
Helping Afghan Evacuees

SHELAA Sites

[Winchester CC Identifies Further Potential Development Sites in Crawley](#)



As part of the ongoing process to develop and update the Local Plan for the Winchester District, the City Council has updated and revised its maps of SHELAA sites that have been put forward for development within Crawley Parish. Following a call for further sites in 2021, the latest map provided shows an increased number of sites being made available throughout the Parish. We will let you know when more detailed maps are available on the WCC web site. See map.

Earlier this year, WCC asked Crawley Parish Council to start looking at proposed SHELAA sites to establish its support of their development and to identify any other areas that had not been put forward. The Parish Council has not been invited to follow this up with WCC, but expects to be consulted this autumn. We will keep you posted.

Currently, the Parish Council is only supportive of sensitive development on brownfield sites that are in-keeping with the Village Design Statement.

For information: The SHELAA is a document that provides information on sites; submitted by Landowners and Agents, for potential housing and economic development in relation to their suitability, availability and achievability. The SHELAA will only identify sites which have been submitted to the council, it does **NOT** allocate sites. Site inclusion does not imply that the council would necessarily grant planning permission.

The Parish Council would like your views on the suitability of the proposed SHELAA sites for development within Crawley. Please email clerk.crawley@parish.hants.gov.uk with your thoughts, to help us form our official response to future consultation.
